Supplementary Regulations

1. The Sixty and Worcestershire Motor Club Ltd. will organise a clubsport permit Autotest on 16th June 2019 at

Mill Farm, Castlemorton, Malvern, WR13 6BQ map ref 150/783372

2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FISA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the Club may issue for the event.

3. M.S.A. permit TBC.

4. This event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club.

5. All competitors must produce a valid club membership card.

6. This event is a round of the Sixty and Worcestershire Motor Club Off-Road Championship.

7. The programme of the meeting will be:-

Scrutineering starts at 10.00 a. m.

First car starts at 11.00 a. m.

Any competitor not signed on by 11.00 a. m. may be excluded

8. Public roads will not be used as link sections. There will be at least six tests on private land. Details of the tests will be issued at signing on. The entry may be split into groups starting at different tests. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the M.S.A. General Regulations. Competitors will have two attempts at each test and will only count the best result. The test surfaces will be grass.

9. The event will consist of two classes:-

A. Front wheel drive

B. Rear wheel drive

All vehicles must comply with the M.S.A. Technical Regulations and must be fitted with a horn and silencer. Four wheel drive cars will be permitted to enter but will have their penalties increased by 10%

10. Awards will be presented as follows:-

1st Overall

1st in each class

1st Novice (not won an award in an autotest before)

1st Lady

Additional awards may be added subject to entry numbers

No one can win more than one award

11. The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and closes on Sunday 16th June. The entry fee is £12-00, unless it is your first ever autotest in which case it is £6-00 All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee

13. The maximum entry for the meeting including reserves is 30, the minimum is 10. The maximum for each class is 20, the minimum is 2. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Entry fees may be refunded, less £1 if notified in writing before the closing date.

14. Other officials are:-

15. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event.

16. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with C5.

17. Competitors will be identified by car numbers.

18. All other General Regulations of the M.S.A. apply as written.

19. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the meeting in the event of unforeseen circumstances. In the event of cancellation entry fees will be refunded

20. Cars may be entered more than once by different drivers.

21. Details of tests will be issued at signing on. Each driver will have two runs at each test only the best result to count. Timing will be by hand held stop watch. Starting signal will be verbal. Starting order will be at the organisers discretion

22. Practicing will not be allowed. (This includes any test driving, hand-brake turns etc. around the paddock)

23. Posts and pylons may be less than 1m in height.

Mud and Snow tyres are not permitted.

24. Entries can be accepted from junior entrants aged 16 and over who have not got a full driving licence but the vehicle must be a touring car and have a maximum capacity of 1400cc and no forced induction.

25. Awards will be presented after the finalisation of the results.

Please Note. The club car will be available, however if you require the car organisers must know at least one week in advance
